- More than 50 participants
- At least two congress days (one night at hotel)
- Participants from at least three countries

The statistic includes both congresses won by Wonderful Copenhagen and congresses arranged without the help of Wonderful Copenhagen. Included you will find statistics for the previous years 1995-2005 and future years 2006-2011. The numbers for 2006-2011 are preliminary indicators and should be seen as such.

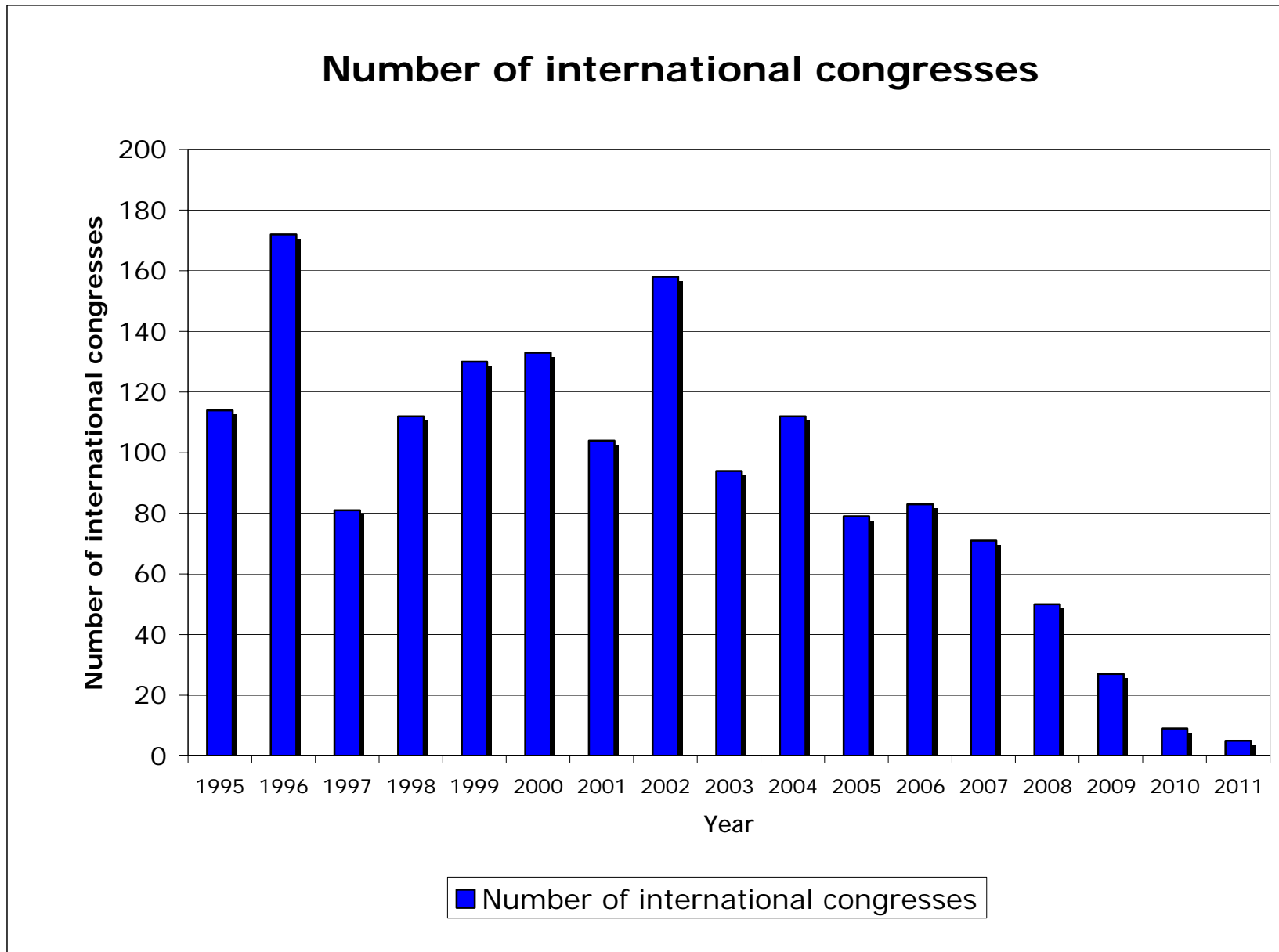

Participants at international association congresses (1995-2011)

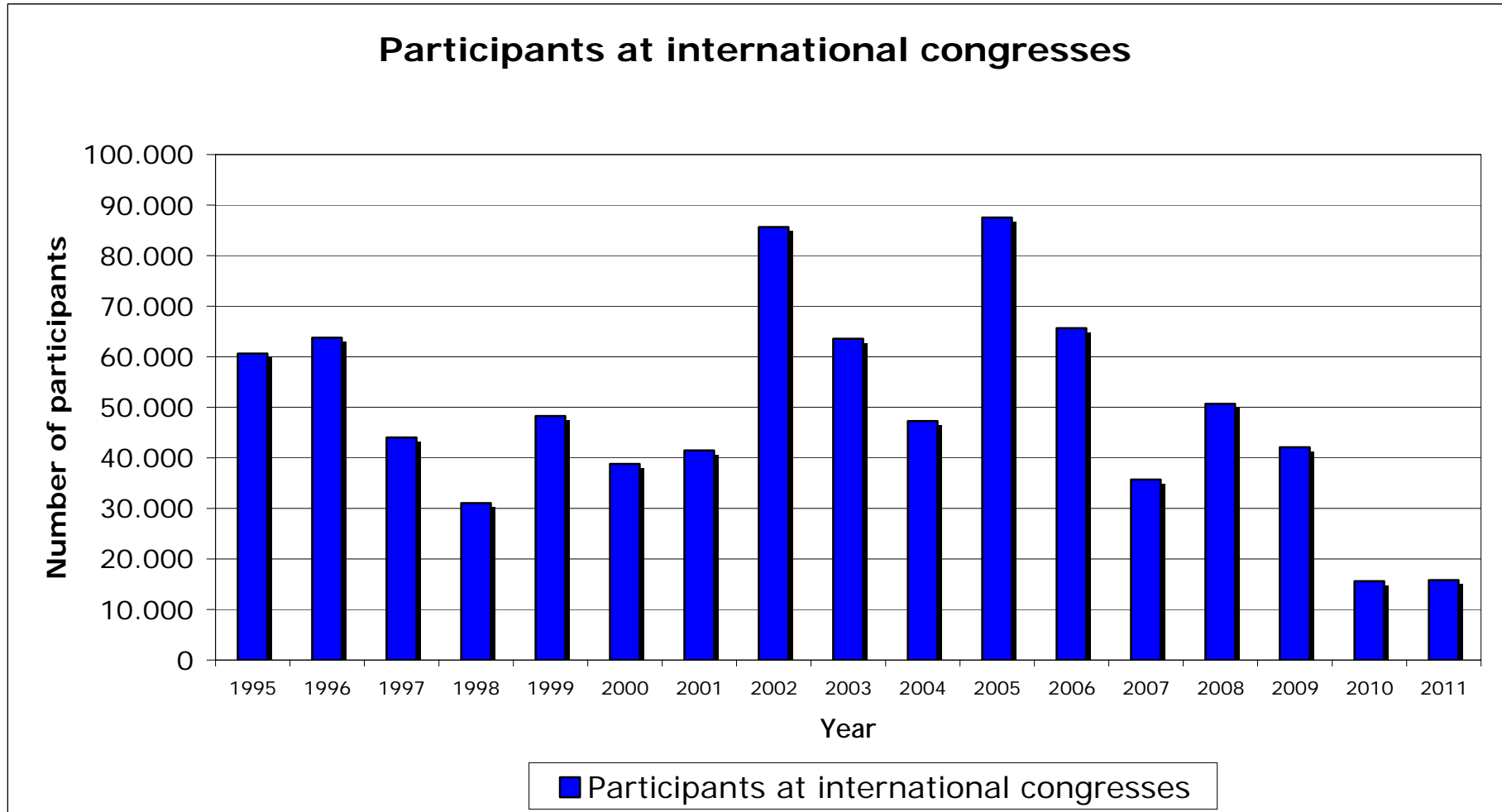

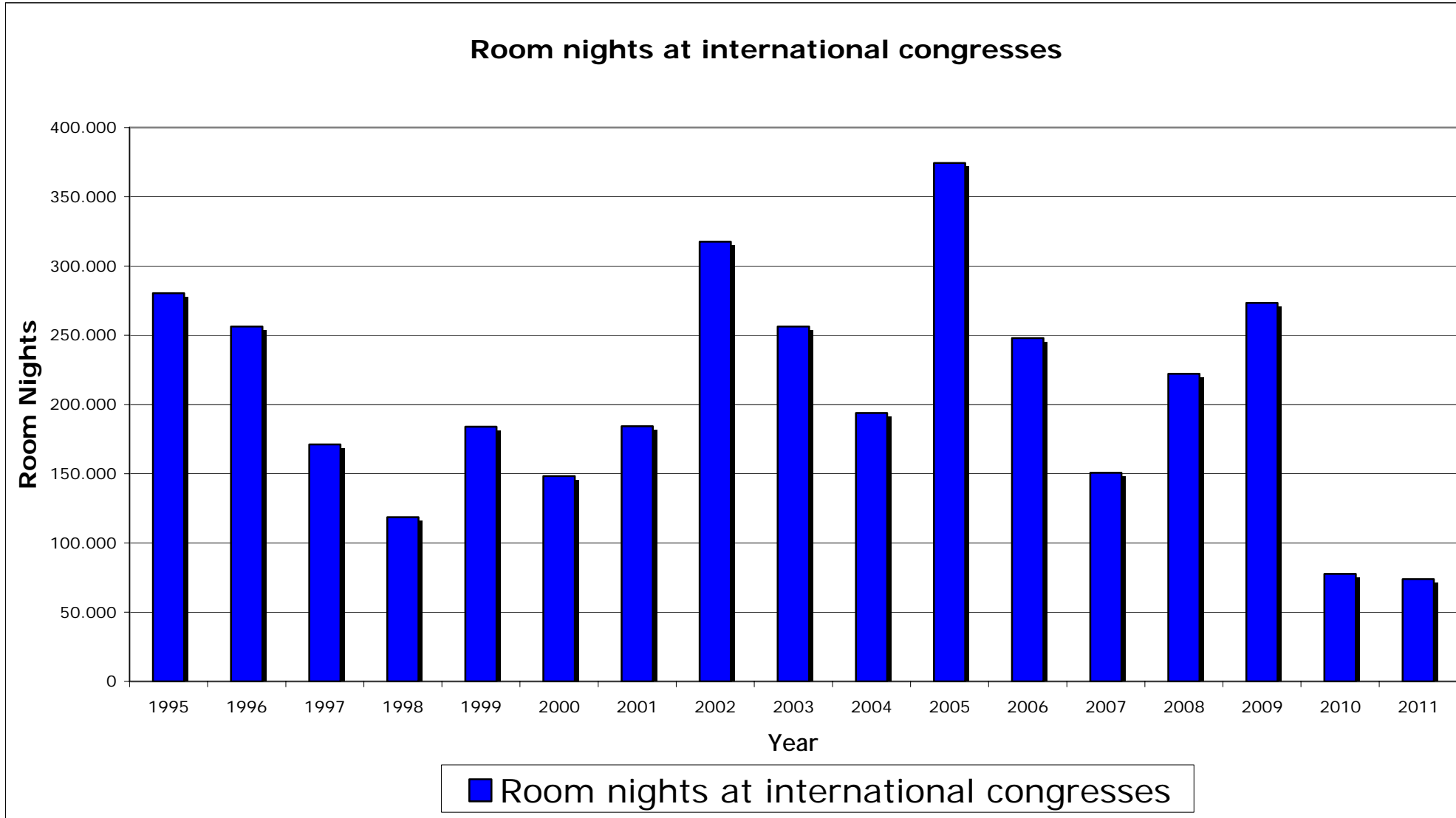

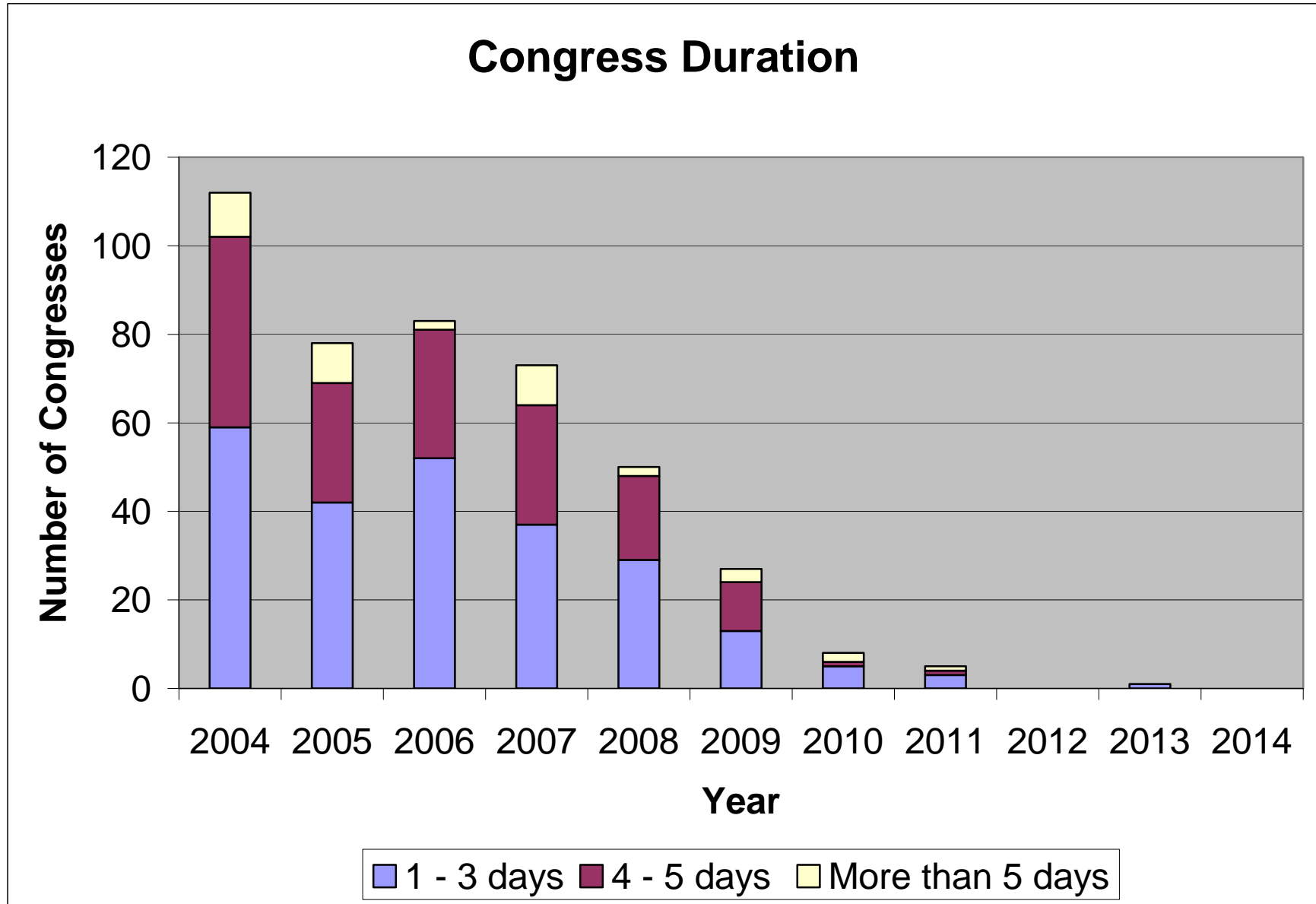
