CITY MAP

PUBLIC TOILETS

Free toilets for the guests at the Welcome Area at the pier.

ATM

Several ATMs in the city center approx. 800 meters from the Welcoming Area at the pier.

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

In the Tourist Information in the Welcoming Area (no commission).

TAX FREE REFUND

Guests can get the refunds at the department stores Magasin and Salling.

WIFI

Free wifi at the Tourist Information in the Welcoming Area. Otherwise most museums and cafés offer free wifi to their guests.

STORE LUGGAGE

It is possible to store luggage at the Train Station (approx. 1,5 kilometer from the Cruise Pier).

PUBLIC TRANSPORTION

By foot or bicycle.
