PUBLIC TRANSPORTION

By foot, shuttle train or taxi.

By taxi, shuttle train or walk.

GETTING AROUND IN THE CITY

The city is less than 2x2 km wide, therefore walking would be ideal, but taxi and sometimes also a small shuttle train are possible.
